Combining spacious interiors with versatile outdoor decks, she is ideal for family and friends seeking luxury at sea. She accommodates 11 guests in five staterooms, including a main-deck master suite with office, two VIP staterooms, and a twin cabin with an additional Pullman berth. Social areas feature two salons on the main and upper decks, with the main salon offering a large lounge and formal dining area.

Outdoor amenities include a sun deck with Jacuzzi and sunbathing area, an upper aft deck with large alfresco dining table, and a main aft lounge. The yacht also features a spacious garage with a wide range of water toys: two Sea-Doo jet skis, two Seabobs, paddleboards, inflatable slide, trampoline, water skis, wakeboards, and towables. She is certified as an RYA watersports center, allowing guests to safely use personal jet skis.

Powered by twin 1,500 hp Caterpillar engines, **LA TANIA** cruises at 12 knots with a range of 3,500 nautical miles, offering comfortable long-range passages. With her combination of space, amenities, and charter experience, **LA TANIA** is the perfect choice for unforgettable holidays on the water.

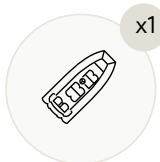

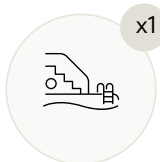

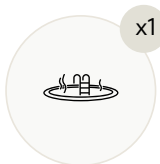
