BLUE AZUR

BLUE AZUR is a motor yacht built by **Mangusta (Overmarine)** in 2007 and extensively refitted in 2025. She represents the highly sought-after **Mangusta 130** model, known for her high speeds, iconic profile, and proven performance. The exterior design is by Stefano Righini.

Accommodation is provided for up to 12 guests across five cabins. Midship on the lower deck is the full-beam master suite, while the bow hosts a spacious VIP cabin. Additionally, there are two double guest cabins and a flexible four-berth cabin ideal for families. The crew of seven is housed separately, ensuring guest privacy and smooth operation of service areas.

The main saloon combines an aft lounge area with a dining space forward. A retractable roof allows the space to be transformed, visually expanding the interior and enhancing the open-air experience.

BLUE AZUR cruises comfortably at around 25 knots and reaches a maximum speed of 32 knots, making her an excellent choice for fast passages between destinations. The yacht's selection of water toys includes a Castoldi tender, a Yamaha GP jet ski, and onboard fitness equipment for training at sea.
