ALFA G

ALFA G is a 60-metre superyacht, built by **Oceanco** in 2004 and extensively refitted in 2024. She features a steel hull, aluminium superstructure, and teak decks. Accommodation is for 12 guests in six cabins, supported by a crew of 18, ensuring high-level service and privacy on board.

The yacht is powered by twin Caterpillar 3512B DITA engines, with a cruising speed of 12 knots, maximum speed of 15 knots, and a range of up to 5,500 nautical miles. The 2024 refit included upgrades to navigation, control systems, and interior refurbishments.

Exterior decks feature a sundeck with pool, beach club, upper deck cinema, as well as lounges and alfresco dining areas. There is a tender garage and a dock for water toys. Active water recreation is supported with Seabobs, kayaks, SUPs, foilboards, wakeboards, water skis, inflatables, and diving and fishing equipment.

ALFA G is ideal for long-range cruising and transatlantic passages, combining spacious living areas with functionality. She is charter-ready, offering flexible leisure arrangements for large families or groups, allowing every guest to enjoy their preferred style of onboard recreation.
