CAPTAIN MORGAN III is a 40-metre **Sunseeker** motor yacht, delivered in 2020 and refitted in 2025. She combines high performance, contemporary styling and one of the strongest charter programs in her category.

Accommodation is arranged for 10 guests in five cabins. The main-deck master suite includes a private walk-in wardrobe and a generous bathroom, while the lower deck offers two VIP cabins and two twin cabins.

A defining feature of the yacht is her multi-level beach club, designed as the hub for water activities. Here you'll find an extensive collection of toys, including e-foils, jet skis, Seabob, kayaks, towables, an underwater drone, an Aquabana set, and a 34' Intrepid tender. The decks are intentionally kept free of toy storage, ensuring clean, uncluttered lounging and dining areas.

Outdoor spaces include a sundeck with a dining area, panoramic views and a jacuzzi, as well as open-air lounges on both the upper and main decks.

A crew of eight provides professional service, organises activities and adapts each charter to the preferences of the guests.

CAPTAIN MORGAN III is a well-designed, dynamic and comprehensively equipped yacht for both active and family-oriented charters, offering a balanced blend of speed, comfort and high-level hospitality.
