





MEDIALLY

MEDIALLY is a 46.3-metre full-displacement motor yacht built by the Italian shipyard **Baglietto** and delivered in 2015. Designed by Francesco Paszkowski in collaboration with Margherita Casprini, she combines Italian sophistication with contemporary styling and high performance. Following a comprehensive refit in 2024, which included the installation of new generators and a full 10-year class survey, **MEDIALLY** is now presented in excellent technical condition.

With a beam of 9.5 metres and a gross tonnage of 489 GT, **MEDIALLY** offers generous interior volumes and a well-balanced layout for private or charter use. She accommodates up to 10 guests in five en-suite cabins, including a full-beam master suite on the main deck with a private lounge, office, and two bathrooms. On the lower deck, there are two VIP cabins and two twin guest cabins, all with en-suite facilities. A crew of nine is housed in separate quarters, ensuring discreet and efficient service.

Her interiors feature a light, contemporary décor, blending soft tones and natural wood finishes to create a relaxed and welcoming ambiance. The main salon boasts panoramic windows, a comfortable lounge area, and a formal dining space. The sky lounge on the upper deck offers a more casual setting with a bar, card table, TV area, and buffet, ideal for evening entertainment or relaxed gatherings. Outdoor living is a central element of the **MEDIALLY** experience:

- The sun deck features a Jacuzzi, gym equipment, and sunbathing areas.
- The main and upper aft decks provide generous space for al fresco dining and lounging.
- A dedicated beach club at water level enhances guest enjoyment with easy access to the sea and water toys.

Powered by twin Caterpillar 3512B DITA-SWAC engines delivering 1,977 hp each, **MEDIALLY** cruises comfortably at 16 knots, with a top speed of 17 knots. Her fuel tanks hold up to 83,800 litres, offering a transoceanic range of 4,500 nautical miles at cruising speed. Naiad Dynamics zero-speed stabilisers ensure comfort both underway and at anchor.

Her technical systems include:

- A newly upgraded AV/IT infrastructure
- Hamann wastewater treatment system
- Idromar watermakers
- A high-performance air conditioning system
- Tender fleet including a Castoldi Jet 19 and Vanguard support tender, along with a wide range of water toys












